Anyone owning one or more acres of land and residing within the District boundaries may run for, or sign a nominating petition.

The WNRCD will be electing one Board Supervisors supervisor to a term of five (5) years beginning January 1, 2018. The deadline for submitting nominating petitions to your local Conservation District office is November 17, 2017. The call for Associate (non-voting) Supervisors is open to any District resident who expresses an interest and is approved by the Board of Supervisors.
