

FY2021 IMPACT REPORT

Agricultural Assistance

- Directly assisted 45 farms
- Developed 3 Nutrient Management Plans
- Planted **1,600 trees** on farm fields bordering streams.
- Collected 70 water quality samples as part of a tile drain study
- Hosted one farmer listening session about payment for ecosystem services

Forestland Enhancement

- Sold 2,900 native plants to residents in our annual Tree Sale to expand tree cover and improve wildlife habitat on private land.
- Planted 480 trees along the Winooski River in Colchester to restore the riparian buffer at Macrae Farm Park



Outreach & Education

- Partnered with two watershed organizations (Friends of the Mad River & Friends of the Winooski River) to expand the Storm Smart Vermont program to reach more District residents
- Engaged 85 people in educational workshops and events


Watershed Stewardship


- Planted 1,200 trees along Indian Brook in Colchester to restore the riparian bufferafter a dam removal
